### Items Discussed:

**CHRISTMAS PARADE:** 12 lit floats are now sponsored for the Dover Christmas Parade. The HCDA has rented one for \$300.00. Mary Fox has represented the group during the Christmas Parade meetings. The parade is Sat. Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>, line up at 3pm and parade starts at 5:30p. Line up begins at Crater Stadium.

**HALLOWEEN PARADE:** Wednesday, Oct. 25. Line-up at 5pm, start 6:45p. Passed at sign-up sheet around to help with the parade. The Lion's Club food booth will be near Shannon Staffing. HCDA cart to be at corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> and Wooster. We will serve nachos and hot dogs. Fire Chief Russ Volkert will be the Grand Marshal of the parade.
